Now imagine that sparkle shining on the walls of your new love nest. **Angie Crabtree** can make it happen: The San Francisco artist paints portraits of diamonds. It's a skill she's honed for five years, after creating her first work for an exhibit about luxury. "I fell in love with gems and their geometric patterns," says Crabtree, who recently completed her first color paintings: yellow, pink (the most requested hue on her Instagram) and blue. Her brushstrokes have dazzled Chopard (she captured its 342-carat diamond) and brides and grooms. "It's a great way to commemorate your special day," she says. Currently on her easel? A more than 5-foot-tall depiction of a radiant-cut beauty in her client's engagement ring.
